

## **Philippine National Observatory on the Information Society (PNOIS)**

From 2000-2002, the AIJC implemented the Philippine National Observatory on the Information Society (PNOIS), the Philippine leg of the UNESCO Information Society Observatory. The PNOIS is a public service portal that provides information on ICT policies, programs and development that can be shared and utilized to help meet the challenges of the Information Society.

Complementing the National Observatory is the Philippine Communication Centrum Project with the following features: Knowledge Centrum - a resource on information useful for making strategic decisions on selected development issues; Media Museum – features the history and evolution of the communication media in the Philippines (including timeline, who's who, and memorabilia), and e-Library – listing of published materials on communication media in the Philippines. The Centrum is temporarily hosted by the AIJC website ([www.aijc.com.ph](http://www.aijc.com.ph)) but will be restored in the UNESCO National Commission website once its upgrading is completed.
