



RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE XXI INTERNATIONAL FESTIVAL OF CHILDREN'S ARTISTIC CREATION UNDER THE AUSPICES OF THE POLISH NATIONAL COMMISSION FOR UNESCO

“INSPIRED BY CZESLAW MILOSZ POETRY”

The Festival is an annual venture organised by Goleniów House of Culture since 1990. Its main goal is promotion of all forms of arts creation of children. Every year's post-festival exhibition is presented in many towns and cities of our region. After finishing each of the Festivals the best pieces of art are used for numerous charity auctions, which support Polish children.

Topic (theme) of festival works:

In 2011 we celebrate in Poland the Year of Czesław Miłosz, the laureate of the Nobel Prize for literature. Because of the character of this event, we expect that all the works send to us will be tied to Czesław Miłosz poetry.

The organizers don't indicate any limits in interpretation of the topic or in choice of painting techniques. The 100th anniversary of the poet's birth was included into the list of anniversaries with which UNESCO is associated in 2010-2011. The anniversary will be celebrated in Lithuania, the USA, France, China, India, Israel, Russia and other countries. The Festival is organized in four age categories:

First group: pre-school children (4-6 years)

Second group: primary school (7-12 years)

Third group: grammar or secondary school (13-16 years)

Fourth group: youth (16-20 years)

Graphic art:

First group (5-12 years)

Second group (13-20 years)

Other technics:

without age classification.

The dates:

- sending pieces of art – until **09.04.2011**
- jury meeting - 15.04.2011
- opening of the exhibition and handing the prizes – **29.05.2011** at 12:00 a.m.

Prizes for winners:

The prize for the winners will be an invitation to Goleniów. Organizers will cover all costs of the stay for the winners and their adult carers.

The authors of the best works in each age category will be awarded with prizes - mostly books.

Organizers are also able to award the special prizes (in each age category), if the artistic level of the works is high enough.

Additional awards: Festival Grand Prix, the Goleniów Culture House Director's award, the Festival Director's award.

2. The works unqualified will not be returned.

4. Works placed inside rolls will not be evaluated by Jury
5. Works sizes to choose from: format a4 – 21 cm x 30 cm
format a3 – 40 cm x 42 cm
format a2 – 60 cm x 84 cm
6. The information about the authors (their first names and surnames, the ages, the names of institutions sending (school for example) have to be certainly given at the back side of works.
7. All works which will be send on the festival, will be judged by commission appointed by the organizer.
8. The readably filled in application forms should be sent with works. The works without correct forms will not be evaluated by Jury.
9. The prize-winners of the Festival will receive an invitation to Goleniów for a 4 days' visit (26.05-30.05.2011). The visitors arrive on their own cost.
10. The other costs of the stay (food, accommodation) and participating in a bonfire, a trip and the picnic are covered by the organisers of the Festival.
11. Books and diplomas, which will not be received in the Goleniow Home of Culture, may be sent to the recipient's expense with his consent.
