**Project Title: Major Repair of Five (5) Classrooms in Estanza  
Elementary School, Lingayen District II, Division of Pangasinan I,  
Lingayen**

**I. Introduction:**

Estanza Elementary School is one of the schools in the Division of Pangasinan I which was greatly affected by Typhoon Cosme and Typhoon Frank. The school which is situated in Barangay Estanza in the Municipality of Lingayen, Province of Pangasinan is being manned by 24 teachers who are greatly committed to the total development of 501 elementary pupils and 59 kindergarten pupils. All the 24 teachers and 560 pupils are being housed in the 15 remaining classrooms of the school which originally had 23 classrooms. With 21 organized classes, it appears that the school is experiencing classroom shortage. To resolve the issue, the school resorted to double shifting, such that Grades II, III, and IV hold their classes in the morning, while Grades I and VI hold their classes in the afternoon. Although the arrangement proves acceptable, the school still prefers the adoption of the regular schedule/ program because of the disadvantages that were found out wherein the teaching-learning process in every learning area was not well-taken caused by the shortened allotted minutes and the school children are hard up in adjusting themselves to the new time schedule in coming to school and going home. Moreover, the school is anticipating an annual increase of enrollment. Hence, the major repair of the five (5) classrooms is proposed.

## **II. Objective:**

To improve the delivery of educational services and improve the academic performance of Estanza Elementary School through the major repair of five (5) classrooms that will provide better accommodation to school children and teachers.

## **III. Identified Users and Beneficiaries.**

The major repair of five (5) classrooms will benefit the present clientele of the school. In addition, the next generation of teachers and enrollees and other stakeholders of the school will likewise be benefited.

## **IV. Resource Requirements:**

- A. Features – Major repair of five (5) classrooms.
- B. Project Cost - \$ 50, 000 from UNESCO Emergency Assistance.

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
