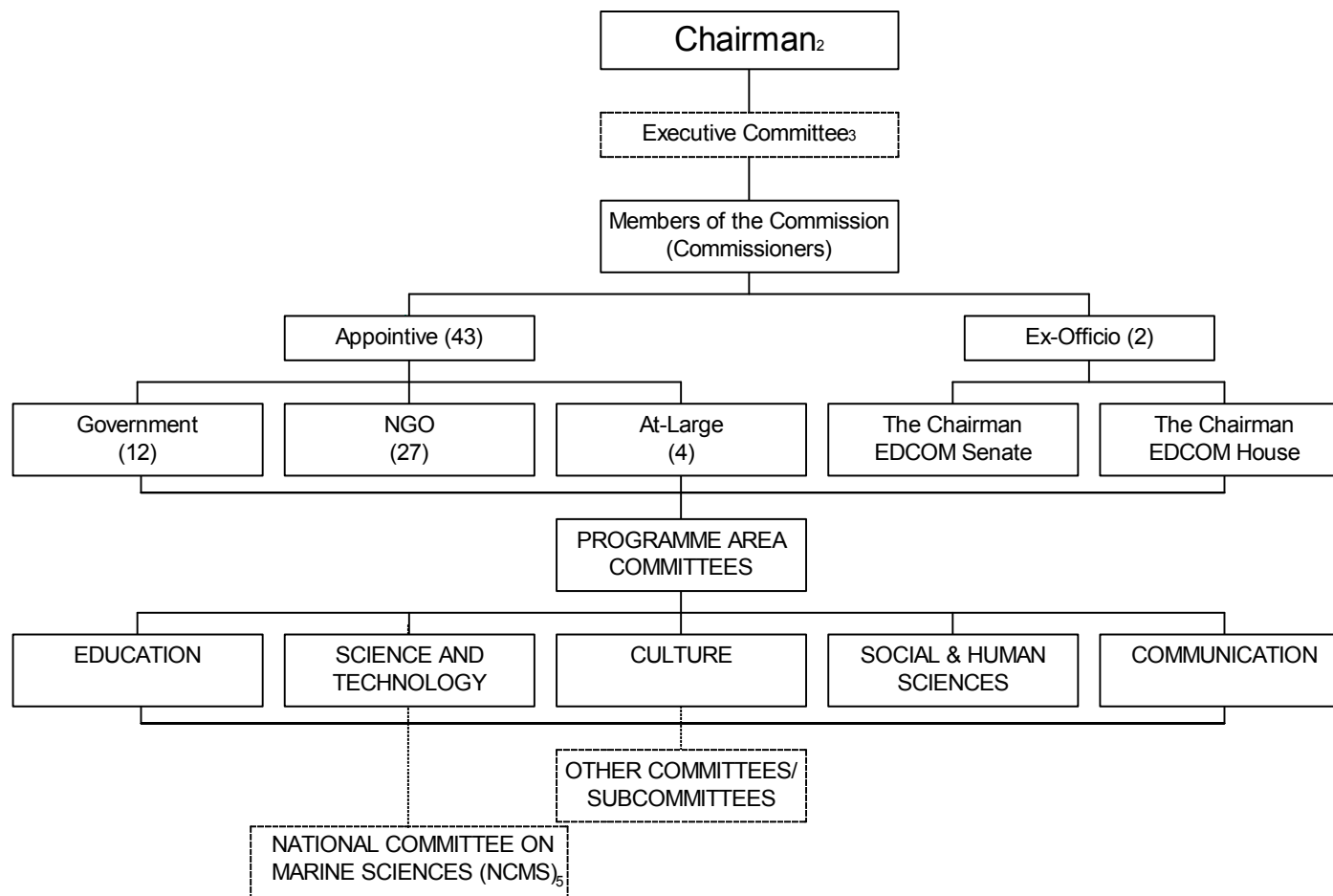

²CHAIRMAN - PD 221 amending PD 1, Sec. 3. "...The Secretary of Foreign Affairs shall be the Chairman of the Commission".

³EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE - RA 621, Sec. 2, as amended, "...The Chairman shall be the presiding officer of the Commission and shall be the head *ex-officio* of the Executive Committee..." The elected Vice-Chairman of the Commission also serves Vice-Chairman of the Executive Committee. Members are the elected chairman of the five programme area committees and four other members elected by the Commission. Two of whom must represent the NGOs and two representing the Gos.

⁴ There shall also be a SECRETARIAT to be headed by an Executive Secretary (Secretary General) who shall act as the Secretary of the Commission, its committees and sub-committees and shall attend to all administrative matters of the Commission.

⁵ NCMS - Philippines Focal point for the UNESCO Intergovernmental Oceanographic Commission (UNESCO-IOC). NCMS is a sub-committee of Science and Technology Committee of the Commission. It was created in 1962 composed of various government agencies.
